The questions, "What would I want for my child if he or she were abused?" and "How can we stop the cycle of child abuse" drive every decision made at Sunflower House.


The agency addresses abuse and neglect through a comprehensive approach, engaging children, parents, child-serving professionals and the community.








Alleged child abuse victims are referred to Sunflower House by Johnson and Wyandotte County law enforcement agencies or Child Protective Service(CPS). When a child victim is brought to the center a Sunflower House forensic interviewer meets with the police detective and the CPS caseworker assigned to the case. Together the team reviews the facts to determine how to proceed with the case.


Forensic interviews are the first step in the child's healing and aid in the prosecution of the offender. Interviews are conducted by specially-trained forensic interviewers within the safe and child - friendly environment at Sunflower House. Interview rooms are equipped to allow the multidisciplinary team to observe the interview through a television screen in the next room: eliminating the child's need to tell their story of abuse multiple times and minimizing trauma. This **ONE** interview facilitates greater professional communication and case management while it begins the process of restoring **HOPE** to child victims.





YOU HELPED US SUPPORT



Sunflower House provides crisis intervention and support to child victims and non-offending family members throughout case investigation and prosecution. The focus is on educating families on the investigative process, advocating for victims' rights and locating resources to meet the families' financial or basic needs so the family can focus on healing the child and prosecuting the offender.

YOU HELPED US HEAL

The goal of Sunflower House's therapy services is to hep children and their families heal from the trauma of abuse and provide hope for their future. Each client's treatment is individualized to meet his/her emotional, psychological and developmental needs using a variety of treatment methods:

- Play therapy
- EMDR therapy
- Trauma-focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy
- Group therapy

Our dedicated team ensure that members of our community know to recognize and report child abuse and that children learn that NO ONE has the right to hurt their bodies.
