CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT FOR MANDATED REPORTERS

Are you a mandated reporter? (Day care worker, dental assistant or hygienist, doctors' office staff, emergency medical technician, foster care worker, hospital personnel, medical examiners, nurse practitioners, police officer, practical nurses, psychiatrist or psychologist, registered nurse, social worker, teachers, paraprofessionals and all other school employees) In this training you will learn how to recognize possible victims, how to report a suspicion of abuse, and how to appropriately handle a child's disclosure of abuse. This training now includes abusive head trauma information as well. This training is approved for 2.5 clock hours, KDH&E.
