# EDUCATION PROGRAM SERVICES

Sunflower House's educational programs are designed to empower both children and adults to recognize and address abuse.

We provide a range of programs for children, from Pre-K through high school. Our Happy Bear Program engages younger children in a safe environment, helping them understand the concepts of welcome and unwelcome touches.

Our adult education programs focus on equipping participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to identify and respond to suspected child abuse. These trainings also emphasize the critical responsibility of adults in reporting abuse.

Additionally, Sunflower House offers all educational programs in both Spanish and English to ensure accessibility for all community members.

# CHILD ASSESSMENT SERVICES

Sunflower House's Child Assessment Team delivers essential services for children suspected of experiencing maltreatment, as well as for their families.

Our facility offers a safe, welcoming, and neutral environment where children can openly share their experiences during a forensic interview conducted by trained professionals.

During their visit, caregivers receive support from a family advocate who provides information on what to expect and how best to support their child.

At Sunflower House, our services are centered on the needs of the child and their family. We bring together a multidisciplinary team of professionals to collaboratively support both the child and their family, thereby minimizing the trauma experienced by all involved.

# THE THERAPY SERVICES

Traumatic experiences can lead to emotions and behaviors that persist long after the event has occurred. Our therapy program supports children and families in navigating these complex feelings.

By prioritizing early identification and intervention through evidence-based behavioral health care, we aim to mitigate the negative long-term effects of trauma on children and their families.

In collaboration with PACES, a provider specializing in children's mental health, Sunflower House offers therapeutic services to any child who undergoes a forensic interview at our facility. We also extend our services to their siblings residing in the home and to non-offending caregivers or parents.

PACES therapists are specifically trained to work with individuals affected by child abuse and trauma. Our therapeutic approach is essential in facilitating healing for both children and their families, enabling them to move forward.

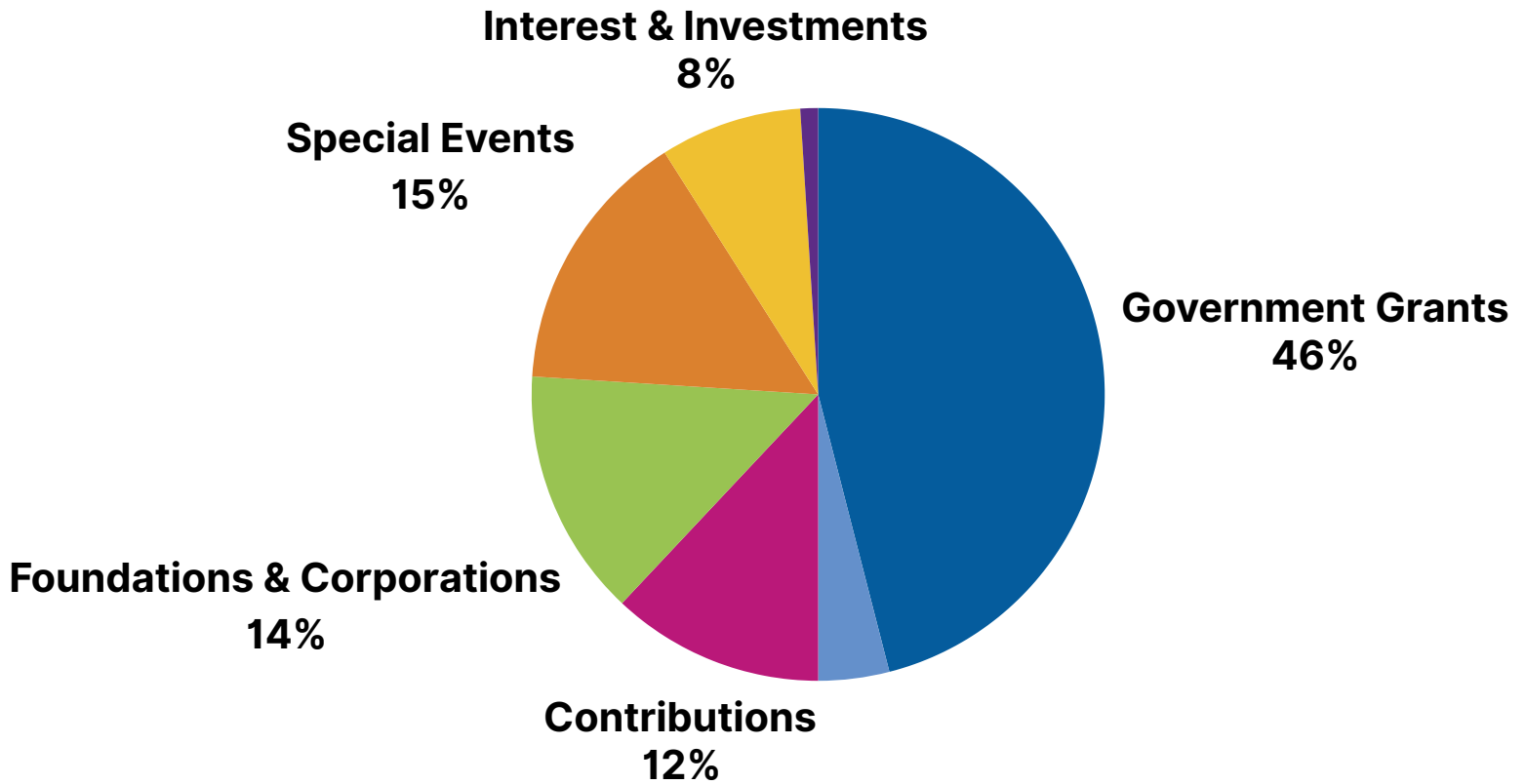

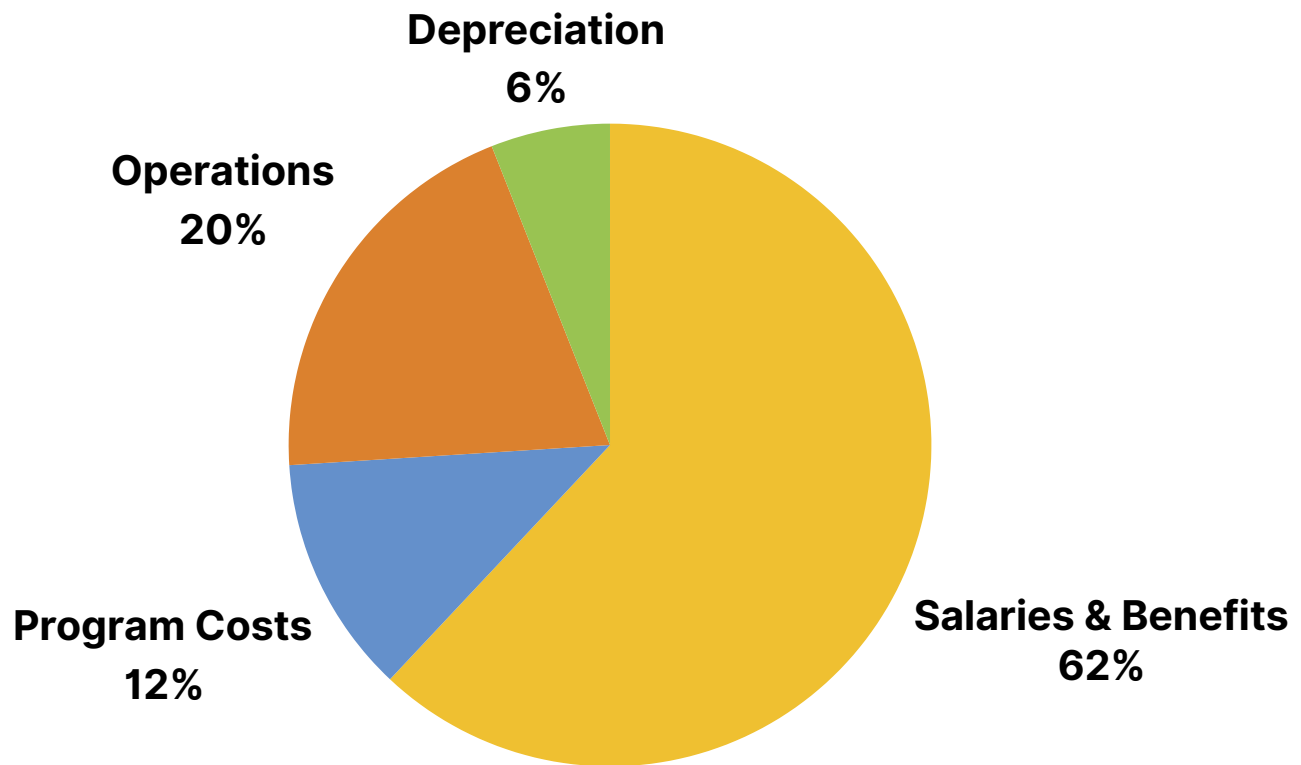
